Participation Rules

These rules are designed to ensure that participants have a healthy and fun experience in a safe environment that is conducive to learning. All participants are expected to adhere to the rules indicated below. Violation of these rules will result in consequences which could lead to immediate dismissal from the camp. Enforcement and supervision of these rules shall be at the sole discretion and judgment of NP-AHEC representatives.

ATTENDANCE: Your participation and attendance in the NP-AHEC Retreat activities is mandatory. Failure to attend scheduled activities, without permission, could result in dismissal from the camp. If you are unable to attend activities due to illness or emergency, an NP-AHEC representative must be notified.

BEHAVIOR: All participants are expected to conduct themselves with professionalism and demonstrate respect for others throughout the entire camp. Behavior that is deemed unacceptable by NP-AHEC representatives will be discussed with the student and/or corrective action will be taken.

VISITORS: Visitors are not permitted to attend the program or participate in the activities of the summer camp.

REMAINING ON THE GROUNDS: Participants are required to remain on the YMCA campus throughout the entire camp. When off-campus activities are held, they will be accompanied by a minimum of one NP-AHEC representative.

USE OF DRUGS OR ALCOHOL: This summer camp is a smoke-free and drug-free program. Any violation of this rule will result in dismissal from the program.

Parents of students under 18 will be notified of rule violations and the resulting consequences which may include immediate dismissal from the camp. If a participant is dismissed from the camp, his/her parents or adult camp participant will be responsible for picking him/her up from the camp upon notification of the dismissal.
